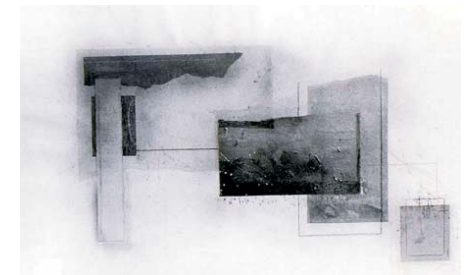
Jacques Cattell Press, and San Diego Artists by Robert Perine and I. Andrea.
