You can find my work at the Offtrack Gallery in Encinitas and the COAL Gallery in Carlsbad. I have been featured artist at these galleries, and have had solo shows at libraries, banks and in retirement homes in the area. I also display my paintings and drawings in group shows. For many years my paintings have been in the annual San Diego County Fair, at Del Mar and are in businesses and homes in France, China, England, Australia, New Zealand and across the United States. I have recently been chosen to be one of a hundred artists to have paintings included in a newly published book by James Lightner, *Land of Sunlight: Contemporary Paintings of San Diego County*. The book is on sale in local book stores and gift shops.

I judge shows for art organizations in the area and give pastel demonstrations at their meetings. I help judge the Student Showcase at the San Diego County Fair and I regularly give demonstrations in pastel painting in the Fine Art Department at the Fair.

For several years I was the instructor for pastel landscape painting classes at Quail Botanical Gardens, in Encinitas, California. Now I give classes at my home studio. Call to set up a date and time for classes.

FALLBROOK'S BRANDON GALLERY TO LET PATRONS BUY ART BY THE INCH

Innovative Fundraiser Scheduled for June 27

Self-selected and freshly painted art comes to the Brandon Gallery for a limited engagement when the first "Art-by-the-Inch" fundraiser in North San Diego County opens here June 27, 2009.

Carol Zaleski, Brandon Gallery's program chair for the event, explained that artists will be assigned set portions along a 33-foot roll of media and then turned loose to paint using colorful acrylics. She said that the blank roll will be unrolled on June 2 at Brandon Gallery when the public can begin to watch the mural's creation. The finished mural will be on display in time for Fallbrook's art-oriented Wine and Walk evening event June 20.

To celebrate completion of the mural, Brandon will host a community reception June 27, from 5 to 7PM. During the open house, patrons of the arts can partner with artists who contributed to the mural and select the best composition in what Zaleski termed "a hands-on, collaborative experience between artist and patron".

When customers enter the gallery for a gala event June 27, pre-sized and priced sampling mats will help make choices easy. Selections will be taped and cut from the roll. With a donation of \$1 per square

inch, the buyer can take home the selection of choice that evening. As an example, Zaleski noted that an 8 X 10 slice from the display would be priced at \$80.

Brandon Gallery, located at 105 N. Main St., one door off Alvarado in the Village of Fallbrook, is a non-profit artists' co-operative with 28 members representing many major creative disciplines. Each month member and guest artists from San Diego and Riverside counties display hundreds of pieces of art that include textiles and sculpture, jewelry and gourd art, oil and acrylic paintings, watercolors and pastels, greeting cards, printmaking, photography and digital media.

CHANGE OF LOBBY/GALLERY ART EXHIBIT

SATURDAY August 1, 2009

TO ALL FAA MEMBERS: We will be changing the art exhibit in the lobby of the Bob Burton Center for Performing Arts at Fallbrook High School, 2400 S. Stagecoach Lane, cross street South Mission. The Performing Arts Center (theater) is located just east of the school buildings near the baseball field.

WE CAN ACCEPT NO MORE THAN 45 PIECES OF ART, DUE TO SPACE LIMITATION, ON A FIRST COME BASIS, ONE DAY ONLY!!

We are working under a time restriction for the day, due to school staffing constraints, so please read the following information carefully. The schedule is planned as follows:

9:30AM-2:00PM Pick up and/or enter new art work. This will be the only time period we have open for artists to pick up their art that has been in the gallery since January and to submit new work for the next six month period. There may be a short lunch break for the building staff, at which time we (FAA) have to vacate the building.

Artwork will not be accepted after 2:00PM, so that hanging the pieces will proceed as smoothly and quickly as possible. ALL ARTWORK, which has been in the gallery since January 10, 2009 must be taken out by the artists no later than 2:00PM Saturday, August 1, 2009.

THEME - No particular theme, just good fine art from FAA Members. Those pieces which depict "Performing Arts" are especially welcome in this exhibit.

THIS IS NOT A JURIED EVENT - Limit two (2) pieces per member on a first come basis, as we can accept no more than 45 pieces. All work submitted for exhibit must be suitable for general viewing. Paintings must be dry, framed adequately, ready to hang with wire attached. No sawtooth hangers. ARTIST NAME, PHONE NUMBER AND TITLE OF ART ON BACK OF EACH PIECE (REQUIRED). Cost for the six month period is \$5.00 for each piece of art, cash or a check made payable to the "Fallbrook Art Association", on delivery of your artwork for exhibit. A 10% commission is payable by the artist, to the "Bob Burton Center for the Performing Arts", for any artwork sold during the the showing. The artist, not the FAA is responsible for any sales tax on items involved in any transaction in this event. We expect to change the art again in 6 months, about January 2010. Anyone who can volunteer, we always need help for the day. To volunteer, or if you have questions please contact Jerry Pennington at 760-731-1180, or sign up at the next FAA Meeting.

IMPORTANT WARNING: PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN THE RED "NO STOPPING OR PARKING - FIRE LANE ZONES" DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF THE THEATER. They do issue parking tickets frequently.
