BRANDON GALLERY READIES FINAL ROUND FOR MINI MASTERPIECES COMPETITION

FALLBROOK, Calif., Aug. 4, 2009 --- Fallbrook's Brandon Gallery announced today selection of 62 entries of fine art juried into its late summer competition -- "Mini Masterpieces".

Carol Mansfield, program chair for the event, said that the juror, Linda Doll, a renowned local artist and internationally respected teacher of watercolor and digital art, made first round of choices for the exhibition from among scores of works submitted last month online to Brandon Gallery. Art accepted for the "Mini Masterpieces" competition represented small works, those no larger than 12 ½ inches on one side in several media: oil, acrylics, digital art, water color, photography and sculpture.

Artists selected in the first round deliver accepted art to the gallery by Aug 10, after which Doll selects the final cash award winners, which consists of three \$200 awards, three \$50 awards, a \$100 juror's award and several honorable mentions.

All 62 of the "Mini Masterpieces" will be on display at Brandon through September. The gallery hosts an awards ceremony and reception September 13, 2009, from 2 – 4PM.

Brandon Gallery (www.fallbrookbrandongallery.org), located at 105 N. Main, one door off Alvarado in the Village of Fallbrook, is a non-profit artists' co-operative with 29 members representing many major creative disciplines. Each month member and guest artists from San Diego and Riverside counties display hundreds of pieces of art that include textiles and sculpture, jewelry and gourd art, oil and acrylic paintings, watercolors and pastels, greeting cards, printmaking, photography and digital media.

We will be circulating a draft copy of the FAA Directory at the September meeting.

This will be your opportunity to make sure that your information for the directory is correct and also that you are listed as a member of the FAA. Remember, you must have renewed your membership in order to be listed in the directory. Please complete the membership form attached to the newsletter, and mail it to the post office box address, or you may also bring your dues to the September meeting.

The expiration date for past membership was July 31, 2009.

Meetings start again in September at Fallbrook public utilities department building at 990 E. Mission. Same time and hours as before (2nd Monday of each month with Eat n' Critique 5:30-6:30 pm followed by meeting and demo at 7 pm, except December when we'll have our holiday party on the first Monday at 6 pm).

LETTER TO OUR MEMBERS (CURRENT AND FORMER)

Hello:

It's been called to my attention that many Fallbrook Art Association members aren't aware of the changes we made in the spring that will take effect this September, and I want to be sure you are informed..

One of the biggest changes we made is that we will no longer be holding our monthly meeting/demonstration at the Hilltop Center. We've arranged to hold them at the Fallbrook Public Utility Department building from now on, which is located at 990 E. Mission. We will still meet on the second Monday of every month, beginning September 14th. We will still hold our popular "Eat 'n Critique" sessions from 5:30 'til 6:30 PM, and our demonstrations will follow the formal meeting at 7 PM. We will also still have our demonstrator conduct a workshop the following Sunday, also still at the FPUD.

The only change in the schedule is in December, when we'll be holding our Holiday Party at the FPUD on the first Monday, December 7th, starting at 4 PM. Be sure to mark your calendars!

The second issue is about the advantages of keeping your membership in FAA current. Because of legal restrictions regarding our non-profit status, we

must continue to open our meetings, critique sessions and demonstrations to everyone, including non-members. However, membership still does offer advantages, including: 1. Only members are included in our directory. 2. Members will be given discounted fees again for workshops. Members will still pay only \$30 to the artist for a full day workshop while non-members will be paying \$40. Considering that we have 9 workshops every year, that's a savings of more than your yearly membership dues, even if you only attend a few! 3. Entry fees into our shows at the Art Center are \$10 lower for members than non-members. 4. To be announced... We're in the process of creating many more advantages for members and we'll be announcing them as they're finalized.

In order to give award cash prizes in our major twice-yearly shows, we had to eliminate our "Members Only Show" because of the legal issues regarding what we could and could not give if our shows excluded anyone. To comply with the law and at the same time to continue to offer an opportunity to every one of our valued members, we created an "Open Judged Show," which means that all entries will be accepted and shown, including entries by non-members. This show will be in November at the Art Center, so start planning what you'll be entering!

Our fiscal year runs from July 1 through June 30 and our membership chair prepares a directory for members in August which he'll take to the September meeting for members to check for possible needed corrections before getting it printed for distribution at our October meeting. If you haven't renewed your membership yet, please do so ASAP. Please send your check (\$35 for individual membership, \$40 for "family" membership, \$100 for "patron" membership which includes a tax deductible portion of \$65) to FAA, P.O. Box 382, Fallbrook 92088. Be sure to include your name, mailing address, email address, phone number and media you work in, either on the form from the newsletter or on a separate sheet of paper. FALLBROOK ART ASSOCIATION MEMBERS WIN AWARDS AT THE COUNTY FAIR FINE ART AND PHOTOGRAPHY SHOW

Thirty-four members of the Fallbrook Art Association were selected by this year's San Diego County Fair judges to exhibit their fine art, sculpture, and photography works. First, second, and third place awards were given to eight FAA members, six members received honorable mentions, and twenty other artists and photographers were chosen to exhibit.

Less than half of the over 1600 fine art entries submitted by artists from the entire county were accepted for the fine art exhibit. Seventy-five of the paintings in the fine art exhibit are the work of FAA members.

Jack Ragland had eight paintings accepted and received a second place and an honorable mention in the acrylic animal category. Natasha Ragland had ten paintings accepted. She was awarded a second place for her painting in the oil animal category and three honorable
