Janice Cipriani-Willis

Watercolorist

Janice Cipriani-Willis is an accomplished watercolorist who began her art education by earning a B.A. in Fine Arts from California State University, Los Angeles. At that time she worked in acrylics and used a loom to weave multimedia sculptures. Her style was exclusively non-representational abstraction. She exhibited and sold her work via the L.A. ArtCore gallery.

A lifetime of vacationing in Yosemite and Yellowstone National Parks, as well as traveling the back roads in between, inspired Janice to express the beauty of the world in watercolors. She sees the pieces of light that play over forms as jewels that form a marvelous mosaic. In her watercolors (in which the lightest light is actually the white of the paper) she rearranges these bits of light into an image of this world's beauty.

Janice's current work has been inspired by watching people from different walks of life in various situations that engender a range of human feelings. She focuses on the beauty and expressions seen in their faces.

Janice is a signature member of Watercolor West, having been accepted four times. into the Watercolor West show. She has studied with California artists Robert Willis and Kolan Peterson and with such national figures as: Don Andrews,

Internationally Renowned Printmaker Featured in September

Freda Fairchild, an internationally acclaimed printmaker, will be the featured artist at Fallbrook's Brandon Gallery in September, capping a month-long series of regional workshops and special showings by the San Diego and North County Printmakers Association.

Fairchild, a former San Diego resident and co-founder of the local printmaking association, resides in Paducah, Kentucky. She will be Brandon Gallery's featured artist September 1-30, 2010, and will host a reception there from 3-5PM, Sat., Sept. 11.

Over the past 20 years her work has won awards throughout the United States and Europe. In addition to producing and displaying artistically intriguing prints, Fairchild has taught art at the secondary and college levels. Her work is represented in private collections that include the National Museum of Women in the Arts (Washington, DC), Grunewald Center for the Graphic Arts (UCLA, Los Angeles) and the Athenaeum Music and Arts Gallery (La Jolla, CA).

Brandon Gallery is the only place where her art will be on display for the entire month. Other venues highlighting printmaking include Fallbrook's Art

Center and the Fallbrook School of the Arts where Fairchild will conduct workshops and demonstrate printmaking

Brandon Gallery (www.fallbrookbrandongallery.org), 105 N. Main, one door off Alvarado in the Village of Fallbrook, is a non-profit artists' co-operative with 28 members representing many major creative disciplines. Each month member and guest artists from San Diego and Riverside counties display hundreds of pieces of art that include textiles and sculpture, jewelry and gourd art, oil and acrylic paintings, watercolors and pastels, greeting cards, printmaking, photography and digital media.

Brandon Gallery is open from 10AM to 5PM Tuesday through Saturday and 11AM to 4PM on Su

Fourth Annual Juried Small Works Exhibition at Brandon Gallery in Fallbrook.

The show opens in November and the reception will be November 6, 6-9 p.m. Daniel Foster is the juror and he will provide a juror's review at the reception.

We will be accepting original 2-D and 3-D work across a wide variety of media including but not limited to painting, sculpture, ceramics, mixed media, fiber arts, photography and printmaking. The work must be original and completed in the past three years. It must also be 14" or less in any dimension including frame.

The final date to submit entries is October 3. We will start accepting entries by CD starting Sept. 1 through Oct. 3, however if individuals are unable to send in a CD they may enter work in person on

Oct. 2 and 3 at the gallery. Both methods of entry are acceptable. See our website: www.fallbrookartassn.org for entry form.

A 10% commission is payable by the artist to the "Bob Burton Center for the Performing Arts", for any artwork sold during the showing. The artist, not the FAA is responsible for any sales tax on items involved in any transaction in this event.

FALLBROOK ART ASSOCIATION MEMBERS AT COUNTY FAIR SHOWS

Twenty-five members of the Fallbrook Art Association have been selected by this year's San Diego County Fair judges to exhibit their fine art, sculpture, and photography works. Both the fine art and photography shows were juried, and only approximately half of the entries submitted were accepted.

In the Fine Arts Exhibit, Lorraine Dawson received a first place award in the oil painting landscape category for her

painting "Murrieta"; Shirley Calvert received a second place in the watercolor still life category for "Just Ducky". Debbie Forbes was awarded third place in the fair theme category for "California Cuisine 101".

The following artists were selected for honorable mentions: Jim Bates for "Angus" in watercolor; Lorraine Dawson for "Vail Ranch" in oil; Penny Fedorchak for "Yosemite in Spirit" in watercolor; Ray Fedorchak for "Afternoon Break" and "Bronc Busters" in pastel; Debbie Forbes for "Retired" in acrylic; Jim Helms for "A Local Landscape" in 3D recycled art; Peg Klinger for "Untitled" in acrylic; Linda Phillips for "Joseph's Time" in oil; and Rikki Reinholz for "Asian Ambiance" and "British Museum Elgin Marbles" in watercolor.
