Subodh Maheshwari will demonstrate floral painting in gouache. 5:30 Eat and Critique, 2 paintings max. 6:30 meeting and demo 8:00 Scholarship Fund drawing.

Subodh was born in Aligarh, Uttar
Pradesh, a state in North India where she
learned folk art and classical music. Her
art is a fusion of Eastern symbolism and
Western composition. Highly individual in
style, her works have been described as emotional,
mysterious, personal and humorous.

She holds a masters of fine art from UCI, and two bachelor degrees in fine art, one from Fullerton and another from Agra, U.P. India. She uses oil, gouache, watercolor, acrylic, pastel and collage and teaches in all mediums including drawing.

Subodh has participated in many shows nationally and internationally including the Fourth Cosmopolitan Exhibition in the 1988 Olympics in Seoul, South Korea. Among her numerous honors is the Regional Fellowship Award at the University of California, Irvine, when she was earning her masters degree in fine arts.

She has taught art at Riverside Community College for the last 20 years and UCI in Irvine. She paints on commission and teaches art classes to all ages. Classes are held on weekdays, weekends and evenings. She gives private and group lessons, and one-day workshops on different mediums and subjects. She judges art shows, lectures and gives demonstrations, as well as teaches healthy creative cooking and Hindi language classes.

She says she gets great satisfaction in teaching and is very proud of her students' achievements.

Jeanne Shanahan, beloved Fallbrook

artist, died Feb. 7 following a gradual decline in health that allowed her to paint actively within just weeks of the end of her life.

Jeanne said she always painted. Her father, a window display artist for department stores in Los Angeles, brought home stacks of sheets of white paper used to pack silk stockings. These became her art paper.

She studied at Choinard Art Institute one year, then married but continued to paint while raising eight children. She and her family moved to Fallbrook 40 years ago. She enrolled in Thelma Houston's painting class at Palomar and was soon invited by Thelma to join her plein air group. When Thelma became too ill to continue as the leader, Jeanne took over. That group redefined over the years, continues today.

Jeanne co-founded the Brandon Gallery with Mary Tomaskevitch.

demonstration by Shuang Li, an award-winning watercolor artist. Emphasizing composition as the key to a successful painting, she was able to find the strong elements in each person's painting before asking, "Now, how can we make it better?" as she proceeded to give very helpful suggestions that, indeed, could accomplish that goal. Many in attendance signed up for her workshop on the 24th as a result of experiencing this sample of her personality and fine teaching ability. The painting she completed during the demonstration was won in our scholarship fund raffle by Al and Barbara Ollivares.





Getting to know Diane Jansen, Art Assist Chair

Diane grew up in Manhattan Beach CA, married young, had two children and then went back to school to earn a BS in accounting and a masters in public administration. She and her



husband moved from Thousand Oaks to Fallbrook in 2002 after his retirement. Her immersion in Fallbrook was delayed since she continued working at Cal State Northridge managing student financial services for another year and a half. On her arrival, she volunteered as FAA treasurer for two plus years combining her accounting skills and love of watercolor.

She took a few art classes in high school and college as electives and tried her hand at drawing, painting, wheel thrown pottery, stitchery and crafts. Watercolor didn't enter her picture until well into retirement. She

considers herself a work in progress and is enjoying it immensely.

She says FAA's Art Assist, a program, in operation 20 years, supplements art education in the 5th or 6th grades. In the past volunteer artists went into the classroom. Recent changes in the schools leave no time for Art Assist. The plan now is to go to the school board and hope to work out a plan for inviting selected students to participate in an art session on a Saturday. Research indicates art education and experience shows improvement in all academic areas and helps with the development of critical thinking skills.

Volunteers are asked to commit to a one to two hour session with a limited number of students on a Saturday. The volunteer creates the lesson plan but many previously used plans are on file. The volunteer brings materials but will be reimbursed by FAA. The idea is to teach one or two elements of design and have a finished project at the end of the session. Bob Burton Center for Performing Arts Lobby display to be changed, April 6, 9:30-2:00, no lunch break. This display, open to FAA members only, lasts 6 months and is limited to 42 paintings, two per person. It is not juried but rather, accepted, first come, first served. Work currently on display must be picked up. A \$5.00 fee per painting payable to Fallbrook Art Association is due on delivery. All paintings must be ready for viewing, dry, framed with wire attached, no saw tooth hangers. Artist's name, phone number and title of piece must appear on the back. If a work is sold, sales tax and a 10% commission must be paid by the artist to the Bob Burton Center.
