### Pastel Artist Joan Grine to Demonstrate

Joan Grine, San Diego pastel artist, will demonstrate at the general meeting October 14 at the library. **Arrive at 5:30 (notice time change)** for the critique followed by a short business meeting followed by her demonstration.

Though she also works in oil, pencil and pen and ink, pastel has been her favored medium since age 11 when



her parents, noticing her talent, sent her to children's art programs on Saturday mornings. She maintained her lifelong interest in art and holds a BA in art from Mary Washington University in Virginia. A favorite subject is natural beauty, especially that of San Diego County. Her preference is painting on location. Her work is owned by collectors in France, China, England, Australia and New Zealand as well as across the US. Recently she was among 100 artists to have work selected to be published in *Land of Sunlight: Contemporary Paintings of San Diego County* by James Lightner. The book is now available in local book stores and gift shops.

Artist's name, phone number, title of work and asking price must be legibly printed on back of each entry.  
**NO** saw-tooth hangers. All work must have screw eyes and wire (ends taped) strong enough for weight of piece.  
Maximum framed width, including diptychs and triptychs, is 50". No height limit.  
3-dimensional piece maximum weight is 50 lbs.  
Paintings, photos, graphics, computer works and mixed media **may be covered with glass if the size is 30"x30" or less** (excluding frame).  
**Plexiglas is required on larger pieces** – except on pastels and charcoal works.  
No work may be removed from the gallery until the close of the show

**Saturday, October 19th**, 9:30-12:30 drop-off and pick-up art work for exhibit at Fallbrook High School, 2400 Stagecoach Lane. The Bob Burton Center is beside the baseball field.

Warning: Do not park in the red NO STOPPING ZONES directly in front of the theater. You may be ticketed.

This is not a juried event but we can accept only 42 pieces on a first-come-first-served basis due to space limitations. This opportunity is open to FAA members only. There is no theme but works depicting performing arts are particularly welcome.

There is a limit of two (2) pieces per entrant. A \$5 fee for each piece submitted in cash or check made out to Fallbrook Art Assn. is due upon submission. All works will hang for six months and may not be removed before the next change-out. Works must be suitable for general viewing. Any work deemed not suitable will not be accepted. All media is accepted with the exception of 3-D. Paintings must be dry, properly framed, and ready to hang with wire attached. No saw-tooth hangers, please. Artist's name, phone number, email, title of work, medium and price (if for sale) must be affixed to the back of each submittal.

Inquiries regarding sales will be handled through exhibit chair, Bev DeVilbis. The artist is responsible for all sales transactions including sales tax in the event of a sale.
