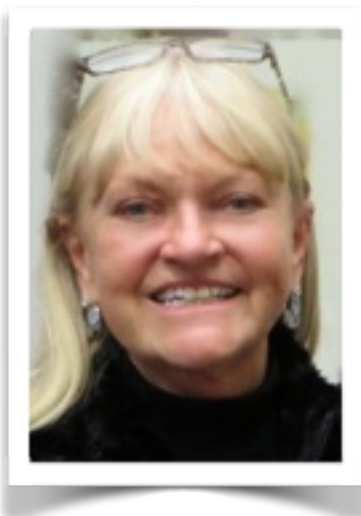

**Dorland Mountain Arts Colony, 36701 Highway 79 South, Temecula, 92592, will host its *Arts Under the Oaks Festival* Sunday, May 18 from 10:00-5:00, free to the public.**

Robert Willis and Janice Cipriani-Willis are heavily involved in this event and with Dorland operations. It has been a working retreat for national and international writers, musicians, performing artists and visual artists since 1979. The art colony is on ten acres of a 300 acre preserve homesteaded in the 1930s by Ellen and Robert Dorland. Ellen was an internationally known concert pianist. She wanted to create an artists retreat like those found on the east coast. At first she hosted friends but incorporated as a colony in 1979.

May 3, 2004, the area was badly burned by the Eagle Mountain fire and most structures lost. In Feb. 2006 plans began for rebuilding. Now it is possible to rent a single bedroom cottage with kitchen, full bath, a workroom, wood-burning stove and covered porch for a week up to three months.
