We are thrilled to share an exciting opportunity for you to showcase your beautiful artwork at the stunning Monserate Winery! Recently, our Plein Air Group had a fantastic day painting amidst the breathtaking landscape, and their creations captured the attention of the winery's management, leading to a unique proposal.

This is your chance to have your work displayed for a weekend, with a focus on captivating "Landscape" themes across all mediums. There are 20 easels available, allowing each of the first ten artists to exhibit two pieces of their art. Just bring your artwork on Friday afternoon and pick it up on Monday morning, and Monserate will handle the sales process, taking a modest 10% plus pay CA sales tax while returning the rest to the FAA for distribution. The FAA will take 10% and give you the rest of your sales money as usual.

SUBMISSION RULES

Artists may enter up to two (2) pieces for consideration in the fundraiser. All mediums accepted with no size limitations. Each piece shall be identified with artist's name, contact information, and title. No AI generated artwork.

Unframed paintings or photographs on canvas are required to be finished on all sides with no staples showing.

Wall mounted pieces must have hanging wire with ends wrapped for safety, sawtooth hangers will not be accepted. Easels and stands for framed or 3-dimensional work are appreciated. Please indicate if they are for display purposes only, or if they will be given to the customer at the time of sale.

3D artwork without hangers must have a stable base when set on a flat surface.

SUBMISSIONS

Entry Deadline: Friday, July 17, 2026 - email submissions only. Please include the following for each piece of artwork:

- Artist Name, Title, Medium, Artwork Dimensions
- Reserve (suggested opening bid amount) and retail price. If reserve amount is not met, artwork will be returned to artist.
- High resolution images in JPEG format, 1MB - 5MB in size, for marketing purposes

SELECTION PROCESS

Due to space limitations at the venue, all artwork will be subject to a selection process. Artists with selected work will be notified by Saturday, August 1, 2026. Selected artists will be required to provide additional information including a brief artist bio and description of the artwork.

***The curators reserve the right to decline any entry which does not comply with these guidelines. All artwork must be presented in good condition.*

DELIVERY OF ARTWORK

Selected artwork must be received before Sunday, August 16, 2026. Deliver in person to Fallbrook Art Association at 119 N. Main, Fallbrook between 11AM and 3PM.

SALES

All proceeds will be retained by the Fallbrook Art Association. Artists will receive a donation receipt for the amount of the sales price.

- August 1 - Selected artists notified
- August 15 - delivery of art to FAA
- September 26 - Event night
- September 29 - All unsold artwork must be picked up at FAA Gallery
