Save the date to see featured artist Igor Koutsonko give a Demo and Workshop on Print Making. Members are still talking about the last time Igor gave his Print Making Workshop!

He plans to demonstrate and teach the Relief printmaking process, Linocut in particular.

You will carve a block of linoleum and then print a small edition of original prints. You can then make an image of your choice, but one option can be handmade Christmas cards. You can print a few of them.

Igor can provide all the materials. He will bring his own carving tools, rollers and some other things for students to use. Students can just bring their sketchbooks, pencils and paper towels.

The charge for the workshop will be \$40 plus \$25 supply fee. It will include fine printmaking paper, linoleum blocks, special ink, and newsprint paper.

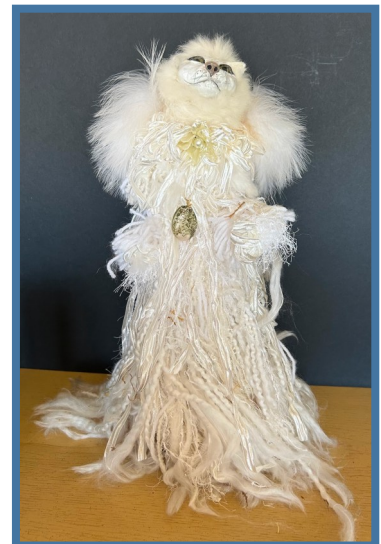

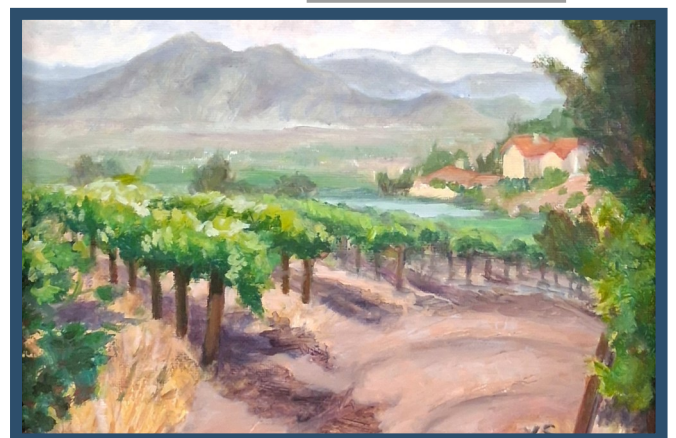
